COURSE UNIT SELECTION

Visiting International students may enroll in a range of English medium courses across various disciplines. Students will be granted entry to the courses of their choice provided:

- ♦ The courses are available - not all listed courses are offered every semester or year. Check listing of tentative courses per semester on relevant websites. You may choose other courses that you are interested in from the complete list. If you are interested in credit transfer, please submit for approval more courses than needed to allow flexibility. Course submission for credit transfer approval should be completed prior to departure from your home university. It may be easier to take courses in Thai Studies as elective courses, not as core courses in your degree program.
- ♦ Approval to enroll in courses is given by the relevant Faculty office.
- ♦ Applicants have the necessary pre-requisite background, if required by the Faculty. Background knowledge is recommended for those taking Business Law, Taxation and Thai Economy.
- ♦ Thai Studies Certificate: Thai Language courses are normally taken in sequence; for those who have higher Thai language skills LG126 and LG 127 may be waived without credit. The student will then need to add two 3-credit courses to fulfill the ten-course requirement of the Certificate. Note LG 126 is a 3-credit course even though there will be 5 contact hours per week.
- ♦ Applicant wishing to apply for **Thai Studies Program** (whether as an exchange student, to achieve the certificate, or for a non-degree study) **must** register for **at least 3** Thai Studies courses each semester.

Without fluent Thai language usage an international student will enter into one of the English-medium programs. Please contact the International Office in advance if interested in studying in regular Thai classes. 
